 The government supports capitalism by encouraging and protecting a free enterprise system that allows competition in free markets to set the supply, demand, and prices for most goods and services.

• The government also regulates the economy and provides many good and services to the people.

 The factors of production are the basic resources needed to make all goods and services.

 Land includes property and all natural resources, including minerals, water, and plants.

Capital includes all human-made resources, such as buildings, machinery, and materials.
Labor includes all the types of work done by individuals.
